Hotel Reservations

If you make your reservations by phone, be sure to identify your group as TAHV or Texas Association of Healthcare Volunteers to receive the conference rate. **The hotel deadline for the \$175.00 room rate is April 18, 2025.**

Guest accommodations will be available at 4:00 p.m. on arrival day.

Guests staying at the hotel can enjoy a full breakfast every morning and the manager's reception every evening, included in the room rate.

Parking at the hotel is convenient and reasonably priced. Self-parking in the garage is \$8.00 per day for our attendees.

Convention Hints & Tips

Directions to the hotel: We recommend using a navigation app if you have one. We also recommend a Texas Toll Tag. If you have a Toll Tag it will work in the DFW area – tolls are discounted with a Toll Tag. If you fly in, you can make reservations for Super Shuttle transport from the airport to the hotel at www.visitfrisco.com.

From the south: Take I-35N, I-35EN, to exit 429C for Dallas North Tollway N. From the Tollway, take the exit toward Gaylord Pkwy/ Warren Pkwy. Merge onto Dallas Pkwy. Turn right on Gaylord Pkwy, right on Parkwood Blvd., right on John Q. Hammons Dr.

From the north: take US-75S, exit 38C onto Sam Rayburn Tollway. Exit toward Parkwood Blvd/Dallas Pkwy. Merge onto TX-121 S. Turn right on Parkwood Blvd, left on John Q. Hammons Dr.
